

**Timeline of key events to support Year 11 students' academic success and progression to post 16 studies.**

<b>Date/s</b>	<b>Event</b>
2 September	<b>Kick start.</b> Y11 online target setting meeting with an FBS teacher.
September – December	<b>Post 16 progression.</b> Understanding course requirements, subjects to study and the application process. Careers guidance is given via tutor time, assemblies and personal career interviews.  Students will complete a range of activities to support them with their post-16 interviews.
28 September	<b>FBS Annual Careers Fair</b> with a range of post 16 providers presenting. Students visit different providers to hear about the courses and hear first-hand from some Year 12 students about post 16 study.
Mid September - December	<b>After-school revision programme</b> launched. Some students will have to attend compulsory sessions in targeted subject areas.
October - December	<b>College and 6th form open days / twilights.</b> We publish the main local ones and these will be promoted by individuals at the event on the 28 September. Students must also be proactive in checking websites for these dates.  Students submit 6th form and college applications.
October - November	<b>Year 11 in class subject assessments</b> testing knowledge, skills and understanding since the June mock exams.  Countdown to December mock exams.
5 – 15 December	<b>Mock exams</b>
January  11 January	<b>Reference grades sent to post 16 providers.</b> These grades are an indication of what a teacher believes a student can achieve influenced by mock results, teacher assessments and attitude to learning.  Most college and 6th form applications close by 31 January.  <b>Y11 Parents' Evening and mock exam results.</b>  SEND evening to support post 16 pathways for targeted students.
January – Feb half term	<b>After school revision programme</b> continues in targeted subject areas, following scrutiny of the autumn term in class assessments and mock results.
Advance dates	<b>GCSE revision sessions run annually in targeted subject areas during Easter holidays and May half-term.</b>  <b>GCSE exams 2023 – mid May to the end of June.</b>
